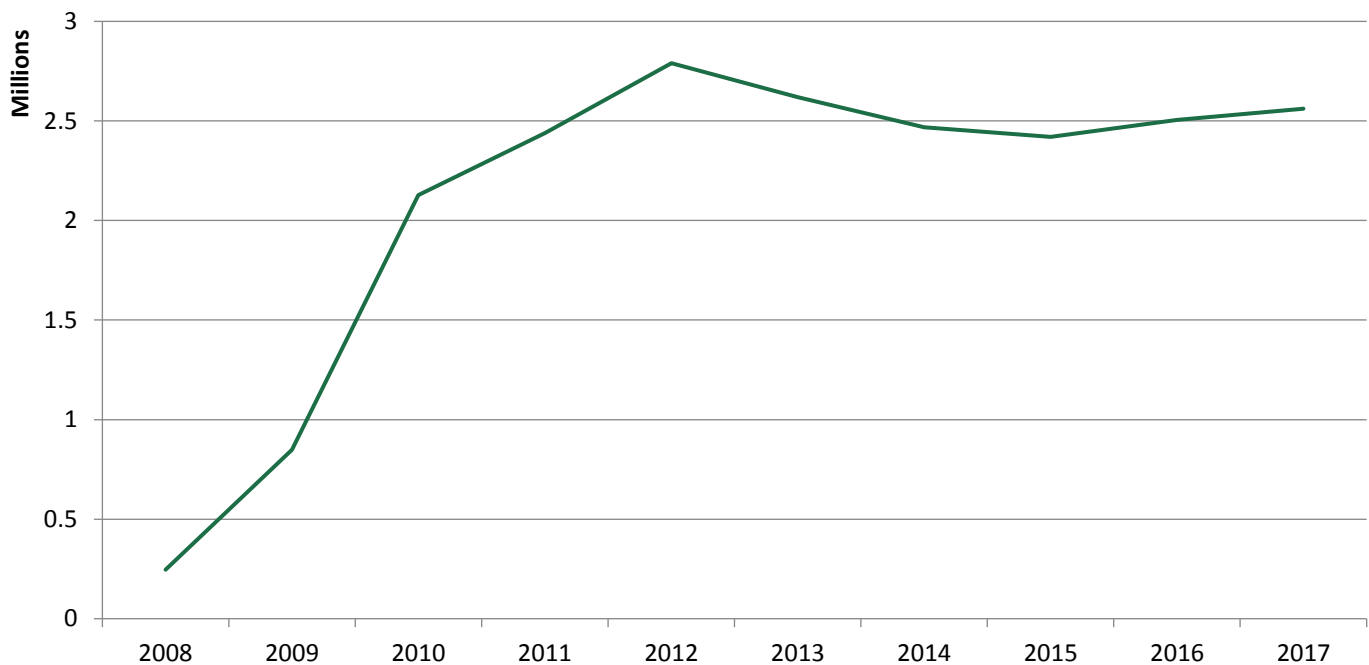


Bibliographic Records 2008-2017

Beginning with clean-up efforts in late 2013, we saw a significant decrease in the number of bibliographic records in the system which represented significant work on the part of our catalogers and support staff to reduce the number of duplicate records stored in the database. Our numbers are on the rise again, but regular deduplications and continued staff cleanup efforts mean that this increase more accurately reflects growth of unique holdings.

We continue to maintain an outstandingly diverse collection, adding thousands of new and unique bib records each year, while making it easier for patrons and staff to locate and procure the desired materials.
